### Smells from the TV

New TVs can cause unusual smells when they are switched on for the first time. Due to the manufacturing process of the components, the television and other electronic products may have parts that produce odors when they are first turned on and warmed up. The smell usually disappears after a few days of use and does not return. This is normal and occurs with many electronic devices. Ensure that there is sufficient ventilation in and around the device so that the smell can disappear.

### Antenna/Cable Connection



- a. Connect the Plug of the antenna cable or CATV cable to the cable (not provided with this unit), then connect to the antenna input of this unit for best reception.
- b. If the antenna cable in your home is other than the above two or you have problems in installing the antenna, please contact your dealer.

### Notes:

- a. Current outdoor antenna or cable TV use 75 OHM coaxial antenna cable. For better reception suggest this kind of antenna cable
- b. Flat cable or indoor antenna are old designed, the reception may not be good enough

**Contrast** Adjust the highlight intensity of the picture, but the shadow of the picture is invariable.

**Brightness** Adjust the optical fiber output of the entire picture, it will affect dark region of the picture.

Color Adjust the saturation of the picture based on your own liking

**Tint** Use in compensating color changed with the transmission in the NTSC code. **Sharpness** Adjust the peaking in the detail of the picture

### Color Temp

Change overall color cast of the picture

Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Color Temperature, then press **OK** button to enter sub-menu. Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Color Temperature. (Available Picture mode: Cold, Normal, Warm).

Change the value of red, green and blue when the color temperature is in **User** mode



**Cold** Increase the blue tone for the white. **Normal** Set to default color temperature. **Warm** Increase the red color for the white

### **Noise Reduction**

Filter out and reduces the image noise to improve picture quality. Press ▼ / ▲ button to select Noise Reduction , then press **OK** button to enter sub-menu.



Off Select to turn off video noise detection. Low Detect and reduce low video noise. Middle Detect and reduce moderate video noise. High Detect and reduce enhanced video noise. Default Set as Default.

### Sound

Press **MENU** button to display the main menu. Press **<** / **>** button to select **SOUND** in the main menu



Press  $\mathbf{\nabla}$  /  $\mathbf{\Delta}$  button to select the option that you want to adjust in the **SOUND** menu.2. Press **Enter** button to adjust.
