
Safety information

- 1. This product is not a toy. Keep it out of reach of children.
- 2. Warning: This product includes AAA batteries. Only use AAA batteries in remote control.
- 3. Keep product and batteries out of the reach of children and pets to avoid chewing and swallowing.
- 4. Never use old and new batteries or different types of batteries together. Remove the batteries when you are not using the system for a longer period of time. Check the polarity (+/-) of the batteries when inserting them in the product. Wrong positioning can cause an explosion.
- 5.Product operating and storage temperature is from 0 degree Celsius to 40 degree Celsius. Under and over this temperature might affect the function.
- 6. Never open the product: the device may contain parts with deadly voltage
- 7.Repairs or service should only be performed by qualified personnel
- 8.Please notice that the standby button on the remote control only put the unit in standby.
- 9. The direct plug-in Cable is used as disconnect device, the disconnect device shall remain readily operable. So make sure there is space around the power outlet for easy access.
- 10.Do not expose to heat, water, moisture, direct sunlight!
- 11.To reduce the risk of electric shock, do not remove cover (or back) as there are no user-serviceable parts inside. Refer servicing to qualified personnel.



3.3 User menu



In this menu you can lock menu and channel edit with a code. Default password to this menu is: 000000






4. Installation
